## In the Event of a Fire at ROE

Staff and visitors must be aware of how to respond to fire alarms on site

# Raising the Alarm

If you discover a fire:

- Raise the alarm activate manual call point (break glass).
- Shout Fire! Fire!



## Leave the Building

- Leave by the nearest available exit.
- Call the Site emergency number: ext. 222; or (9)999 out of hours
- DO NOT use lifts.
- DO NOT attempt to tackle fires unless you have been trained, and it is safe to do so.

## **Muster Points**

On leaving building, go to the designated Muster

- Point:
- Assembly **Point**
- If you know the location of a fire inform the Building Warden;
- Follow any instructions given by the Building Warden;
- DO NOT block site access routes for **Emergency Services**; and
- DO NOT enter the building until the person in charge has reported it is safe to do so.

**ALL** Fire Alarms **MUST** be responded to, even if it is known to be a Fire Drill.
