## In the Event of a Fire at SO

Staff and visitors must be aware of how to respond to fire alarms ion site

## Raising the Alarm

If you discover a fire:

- Raise the alarm activate manual call point (break glass).
- Shout Fire! Fire!

## Leave the Building

- Leave by the nearest available exit.
- Call the Site emergency number: ext. 2222; or mobile 01793 444510
- **DO NOT** use lifts.
- **DO NOT** attempt to tackle fires unless you have been trained, and it is safe to do so.

## **Assembly Points**

On leaving building, go to the designated **Assembly Point:** 

- If you know the location of a fire inform the Floor Warden;
- Follow any instructions given by the Emergency Response Team;
- **DO NOT** block site access routes for Emergency Services; and
- **DO NOT** re- enter the building until the Chief Incident Control Officer has reported it is safe to do so.

All Fire Alarms MUST be responded to, even if it is known to be a Fire Drill.
