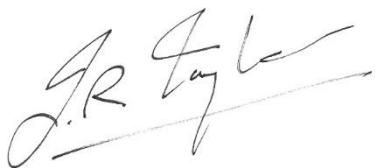

SCHEDULE 1

Dose record keeping (archive only)

1. The keeping of dose records for doses received up to, and including 31 December 1998 in accordance with Criterion 13 [Storage and security of records] and Criterion 14 [Tracing basic data] of HSE's Requirements for the Approval of Dosimetry Services under the Ionising Radiations Regulations 2017, Part 3, Co-ordination and Record Keeping.
2. The making of alterations to the dose records in accordance with Criterion 12 [Permitted alterations to dose records] (e), and (f) of HSE's Requirements for the Approval of Dosimetry Services under the Ionising Radiations Regulations 2017, Part 3, Co-ordination and Record Keeping.
3. The provision of copies, suitable summaries and extracts of dose information to employers as required in accordance with Criterion 16 b (ii) of HSE's Requirements for the Approval of Dosimetry Services under the Ionising Radiations Regulations 2017, Part 3, Co-ordination and Record Keeping.
4. The provision of information to CIDI in accordance with Criterion 18 (d) of HSE's Requirements for the Approval of Dosimetry Services under the Ionising Radiations Regulations 2017, Part 3, Co-ordination and Record Keeping.
5. The provision of copies or summaries of dose record data to relevant Appointed Doctor or HSE Medical Inspector (Employment Medical Adviser) or to other Approved Dosimetry Services when requested in accordance with Criterion 20 [Information for the appointed Doctor or HSE Medical Inspector (EMA)] and 21 [Information for other Approved Dosimetry Services] of HSE's Requirements for the Approval of Dosimetry Services under the Ionising Radiations Regulations 2017, Part 3, Co-ordination and Record Keeping.

SCHEDULE 2

1. The functions and assessments referred to in Schedule 1 to this Certificate shall be carried out in the manner described in the Laboratory Statement reference ADSAPPROVAL2006 Rev 2, supplied by the Central Laboratory for the Research Councils Daresbury Laboratory with their letter dated 8th September 2006.
2. In operating this service regard shall be had to the contents of Part 3 of Requirements for the Approval of Dosimetry Services issued by the Health and Safety Executive pursuant to the Ionising Radiations Regulations 2017.
3. The Health and Safety Executive may formally reassess the approval of the dosimetry service from time to time. The service shall pay the fee for formal reassessment of

approval of dosimetry services as laid down in the Health and Safety (Fees) Regulations current at that time.

4. In this schedule a reference to a Statement of Service statement shall include any amendments or revisions as may be agreed in writing by the Health and Safety Executive.
