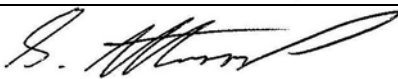

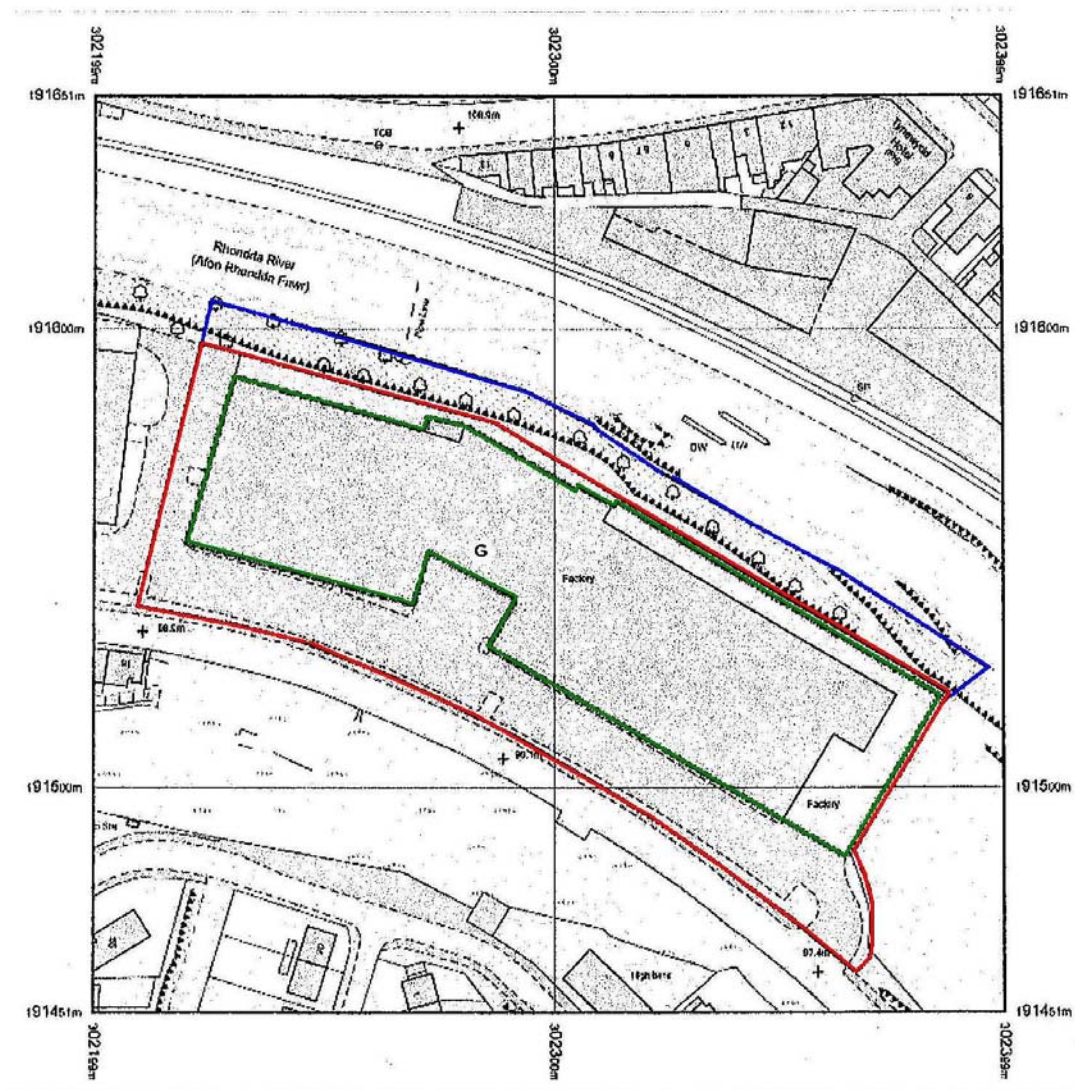

This is the plan referred to in rule 2.3.1 of standard rules SR2008No23



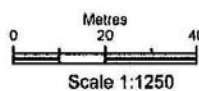
