# **Raising the Alarm**

If you discover a **fire**:

- Raise the alarm activate manual call point (break glass).
- Shout Fire! Fire!

### Leave the Building

- Leave by the nearest available exit.
- Call the Site emergency number: ext. 2222; or mobile 01235 778888
- **DO NOT** use lifts.
- **DO NOT** attempt to tackle fires unless you have been trained, and it is safe to do so.

## **Assembly Points**

On leaving building, go to the designated **Assembly Point:** 



- If you know the location of a fire inform the Building Warden;
- Follow any instructions given by the Building Warden;







- **DO NOT** block site access routes for
  - **Emergency Services; and**
- **DO NOT** enter or re-enter the building

until the Alarm Investigation Team (AIT) has reported it is safe to do so.

#### ALL Fire Alarms MUST be responded to and treated

as real.
